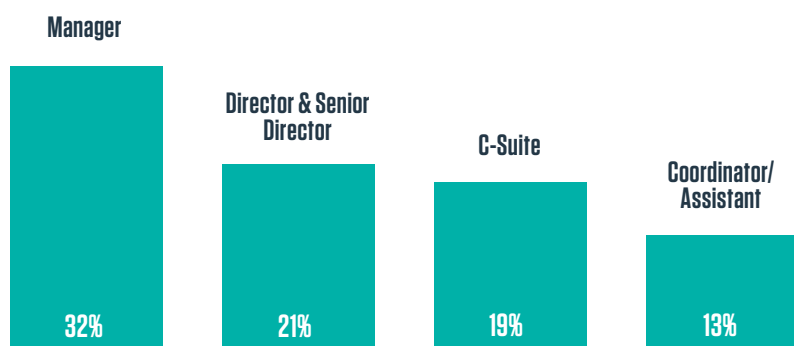


GEOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN

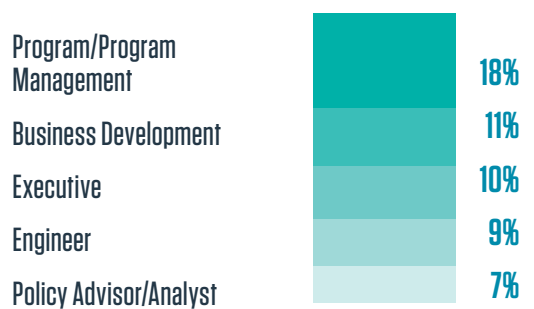
As an event geared towards the Alaska renewable market, most of the audience attended from Alaska.

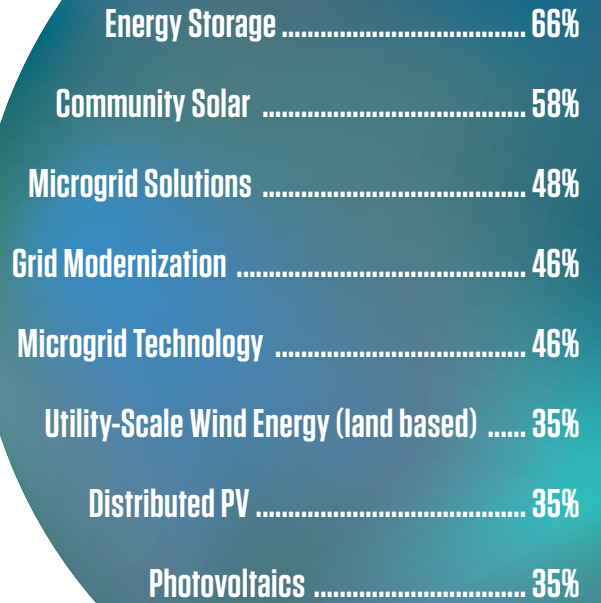
